



Paul Horn Halle (Hall 10)




The Paul Horn Halle (Hall 10) is a timber construction creating a special ambience thanks to the natural building material. At the same time, the building blends harmoniously into the exhibition centre.

The roof is also planted with vegetation and equipped with a photovoltaic system.

Ventilation	Layer ventilation, source air outlets and far reaching air jets
Supply channels	every 6 m
Suspensions from girders	Max point load = 1 kN (100 kg) perpendicular
Utility connections	Water, waste water, compressed air, gas, electricity, telecommunications
Meeting rooms	4 rooms each 40 m ² , divided by flexible partition walls
